

Summer App Developer Camp Leader:

Location: Falmouth/Portland area, TBD

Dates: July or August, TBD

This person is responsible for the day-to-day operation of the day camp. Each camp consists of up to 16 campers, ages 12 to 16. Responsibilities include oversight of the staff, check-in and check-out of all campers for each day, maintaining contact with parents, resolving any conflicts between campers, giving short educational presentations to the campers, securing of the facility (room), resolving equipment problems, and in general providing the leadership and spirit for the camp.

Recruiting and facilitating visiting presenters/reviewers is also part of this position, but can do this in concert with the organizers. During the 2014 season, this position is also responsible for helping design and modifies the curriculum to be used with this pilot group. The camp will be using the MIT AppDeveloper program to teach programming skills. This pilot project is a girls-only camp and the theme will focus on developing Apps for sustainability.

Experience with children is expected and this position is ideally filled by a person with a teaching or educational support certificate and at least 2 years of professional experience.

Training provided during 3 days at the end of June on the Orono campus (housing allowance provided). Standard First Aid/CPR training required (provided if you don't have it).

Supervises: Camp Counselors and up to 16 campers

Reports to: Executive Director

Duration: 1 week

Pay: \$1,000/week

Note: should this become a regular continuing program in the future, weekly rate will be consistent with the MR payscale (2014 this was \$735/week for a 5 day week)

Benefits: None

paid sick pay @ .33day/week for two or more weeks per summer.

3 days of training at the end of June, dates to be announced.
